- 1 A BILL for an Act to create a state employment review commission and to require agencies to
- 2 obtain approval from the commission before filling a vacant employee position.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. Approval required to fill vacant employee positions. An executive
- 5 branch state agency, excluding entities under the control of the state board of higher education,
- 6 may not fill a classified, permanent employee position that becomes vacant unless approval is
- 7 received from the state employment review commission.
- 8 **SECTION 2. State employment review commission Members.** The state
- 9 <u>employment review commission consists of the governor or the governor's designee, the</u>
- 10 director of the office of management and budget, and the director of the human resource
- 11 management services division of the office of management and budget.
- 12 SECTION 3. State employment review commission Duties and responsibilities.
- 13 Upon request by a state agency for approval under section 1 of this Act to fill a vacant
- 14 <u>classified</u>, permanent employee position, the state employment review commission shall review
- and consider the following information before approving or denying the agency request:
- 16 1. The length of time the position has been vacant.
- 17 <u>2. The necessity of the position's duties and responsibilities.</u>
- 18 <u>3. The possibility of transferring the position's duties and responsibilities to other</u>
- 19 <u>agency employees.</u>
- 20 4. The possibility of restructuring agency duties and responsibilities.
- 21 5. The feasibility of contracting for the duties of the position.
- 22 **SECTION 4.** Report to legislative council. The state employment review commission
- 23 shall report biennially to the legislative council on requests reviewed and on the outcome of
- 24 each review.
