- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 23-12-09 and subsection 2 of section 23-12-10
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to exemptions from smoking restrictions.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-12-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - **23-12-09.** Smoking in public places and places of employment Definitions. In sections 23-12-09 through 23-12-11, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
    - 1. "Bar" means a retail alcoholic beverage establishment licensed under chapter 5-02 that is devoted to the serving of alcoholic beverages for consumption by guests on the premises and in which the serving of food is only incidental to the consumption of those beverages. The term includes a bar located within a hotel, bowling center, or restaurant that is not licensed primarily or exclusively to sell alcoholic beverages if the bar is in a separately enclosed area.
    - 2. "Bingo facility" means a business location in which bingo is the primary source of revenue and in which an individual under eighteen years of age is not permitted on the premises.
    - 3. "Business" means a sole proprietorship, partnership, association, joint venture, corporation, or other business entity, either for profit or not for profit, including retail establishments where goods or services are sold and professional corporations and other entities where professional services are delivered.
- 21 3. 4. "Employee" means an individual who is employed by an employer in consideration 22 for direct or indirect monetary wages or profit, or an individual who volunteers 23 services for an employer.

- 1 4. <u>5.</u> "Employer" means an individual, business, or the state and its agencies and political subdivisions that employs the services of one or more individuals.
- 5. 6. "Enclosed area" means all space between a floor and ceiling that is enclosed on all sides by solid walls or windows, exclusive of doorways, which extend from the floor to the ceiling.
  - 6. 7. "Health care facility" means any office or institution providing health care services, including a hospital; clinic; ambulatory surgery center; outpatient care facility; nursing, basic, or assisted living facility; and laboratory.
    - 7. 8. "Health care services" include medical, surgical, dental, vision, chiropractic, and pharmaceutical services.
    - 8. 9. "Place of employment" means an area under the control of a public or private employer that employees normally frequent during the course of employment, including work areas, auditoriums, classrooms, conference rooms, elevators, employee cafeterias, employee lounges, hallways, meeting rooms, private offices, restrooms, and stairs.
      - "Public place" means an enclosed area to which the public has access or in which the public is permitted, including a publicly owned building or office, and enclosed areas available to and customarily used by the general public in businesses and nonprofit entities patronized by the public, including bars; bingo facilities; child care facilities subject to licensure by the department of human services, including those operated in private homes when any child cared for under that license is present: convention facilities; educational facilities, both public and private; facilities primarily used for exhibiting a motion picture, stage, drama, lecture, musical recital, or other similar performance; financial institutions; health care facilities; hotels and motels; laundromats; any common areas in apartment buildings, condominiums, mobile home parks, retirement facilities, nursing homes, and other multiple-unit residential facilities; museums, libraries, galleries, and aquariums; polling places; professional offices; public transportation facilities, including buses and taxicabs, and ticket, boarding, and waiting areas of public transit depots; reception areas; restaurants; retail food production and marketing establishments; retail service establishments; retail stores; rooms, chambers, places of meeting or public

1 assembly, including school buildings; service lines; shopping malls; sports arenas, 2 including enclosed places in outdoor arenas; theaters; and waiting rooms. 3 <del>10.</del> <u>11.</u> "Publicly owned building or office" means a place owned, leased, or rented by any 4 state or political subdivision, or by any agency supported by appropriation of, or by 5 contracts or grants from, funds derived from the collection of taxes. 6 <del>11.</del> 12. "Restaurant" includes every building or other structure, or any part thereof, and all 7 buildings in connection therewith that are kept, used, maintained, advertised, or 8 held out to the public as a place where food is served, including coffee shops, 9 cafeterias, private and public school cafeterias, kitchens, and catering facilities in 10 which food is prepared on the premises for serving elsewhere, and a bar area 11 within a restaurant. 12 <del>12.</del> <u>13.</u> "Retail tobacco store" means a retail store utilized primarily for the sale of tobacco 13 products and accessories and in which the sale of other products is merely 14 incidental. 15 <del>13.</del> 14. "Shopping mall" means an enclosed public walkway or hall area that serves to 16 connect retail or professional businesses. 17 <del>14.</del> 15. "Smoking" means possessing a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, weed, plant, or any 18 other lighted tobacco product in any manner or in any form. 19 <del>15.</del> 16. "Sports arena" means any facility or area, whether enclosed or outdoor, where 20 members of the public assemble to engage in physical exercise, participate in 21 athletic competition, or witness sports or other events, including sports pavilions. 22 stadiums, gymnasiums, health spas, boxing arenas, swimming pools, roller and ice 23 rinks, and bowling centers. 24 <del>16.</del> 17. "Truckstop" means a roadside service station and restaurant that caters to 25 truckdrivers. 26 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 23-12-10 of the North Dakota 27 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 28 The following areas are exempt from subsection 1: 2. 29 Private residences, except when operating as a child care facility subject to a. 30 licensure by the department of human services and when any child cared for 31 under that license is present in that facility.
