- 1 A BILL for an Act to authorize construction of state correctional facilities at the state
- 2 penitentiary; to require a prison facility master site plan and reports to the legislative council; to
- 3 authorize contracting with a private vendor, to provide for the sale of department of corrections
- 4 and rehabilitation land; and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES PROJECT AUTHORIZATION. The department of corrections and rehabilitation may construct correctional facilities consisting of an orientation unit, general housing facility, medical facility, minimum security facility, and maximum security facility adjacent to the state penitentiary and outside the existing security fence, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, at a cost not to exceed \$25,727,128.

SECTION 2. PRISON FACILITY CONSULTANT - MASTER PLAN - LEGISLATIVE
COUNCIL REPORTS. The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall contract with a
private prison facility consultant who must be an expert in prison facility design and construction
for the development of a master site plan, including the design of the facilities authorized in
section 1 of this Act and a design for expansion which addresses future use of existing
buildings at the state penitentiary. The consultant shall present progress reports on the master
site plan and facilities design to the legislative council. The department of corrections and
rehabilitation shall present the department's plan for constructing the facilities to the legislative
council prior to beginning construction of the facilities as authorized in section 1 of this Act.

SECTION 3. USE OF PRIVATE VENDOR. The department of corrections and rehabilitation may contract with a private correctional services provider for construction of the correctional facilities authorized in section 1 of this Act. Contract terms must include a provision

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- to allow the state to purchase the correctional facilities upon completion of the constructionproject.
- SECTION 4. SALE OF MISSOURI RIVER CORRECTIONAL CENTER LAND AND

 BUILDINGS. The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall seek authorization from the

 sixty-first legislative assembly for the sale of Missouri River correctional facility land and

 buildings after the correctional facilities authorized by section 1 of this Act are operational.
 - **SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$48,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of corrections and rehabilitation for the purpose of constructing the correctional facilities authorized in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
