10	worldwide and coproduced a Disney adventure film; and
11	WHEREAS, James D. Ployhar graduated from Valley City State University and was
12	awarded the university's Distinguished Alumnus Award; and
13	WHEREAS, James D. Ployhar was husband to Ruth, a father to Steve, Carol, Debbie,
14	Jane, and Doug, and a friend to many citizens of this state; and
15	WHEREAS, we now pause to mourn the passing of James D. Ployhar and honor his
16	memory for his outstanding service to the people of this state and those around the world who
17	have had the pleasure of hearing his music performed;
