## REENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1064

(At the request of the Highway Patrol)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to creation of the highway patrol assets forfeiture fund; and to provide a
- 3 continuing appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Highway patrol Assets forfeiture fund Purpose Continuing appropriation.
- 8 There is created a fund to be known as the highway patrol assets forfeiture fund. The fund
- 9 consists of funds obtained from moneys, assets, and proceeds seized and forfeited pursuant to
- 10 section 19-03.1-36, amounts received through court proceedings as restitution, amounts
- 11 remaining from the forfeiture of property after the payment of expenses for forfeiture and sale
- 12 authorized by law, and funds received from federal shared forfeiture proceedings. The total
- 13 amount of deposits into the fund may not exceed three hundred thousand dollars within a
- 14 biennium and any moneys in excess of that amount must be deposited in the general fund.
- 15 The funds are appropriated as a continuing appropriation to the highway patrol for the following
- 16 purposes:
- 17 <u>1. For paying expenses necessary to inventory, safeguard, maintain, advertise, or</u>
- sell property seized, detained, or forfeited, pursuant to section 19-03.1-36, or of
- any other necessary expenses incident to the seizure, detention, or forfeiture of the
- 20 property.
- 21 <u>2. For paying overtime compensation incurred as a result of investigations or</u>
- 22 <u>violations of any state criminal law or law relating to the control of drug abuse.</u>
- 23 3. For purchasing equipment related to criminal interdiction.

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1	<u>4.</u>	For paying matching funds required as a condition for receipt of funds from a
2		federal government program awarding monetary grants or assistance for the
3		investigation or apprehension of persons violating the provisions of chapter
4		<u>19-03.1.</u>
5	The superintendent of the highway patrol, with the concurrence of the director of the office of	
6	management and budget, shall establish the necessary accounting procedures for the use of	
7	the fund and shall personally approve, in writing, all requests for the use of the fund.
