## HOUSE BILL NO. 1131

Introduced by

(At the request of the State Department of Health)

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact sections 43-35-15.3, 43-35-18.3, and 43-35-19.3 of the

2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the state board of water well contractors and

3 geothermal installer certification and standards; and to amend and reenact sections 43-35-03,

4 43-35-06, 43-35-11, 43-35-12, 43-35-13, 43-35-14, 43-35-21, and 43-35-22 of the North Dakota

5 Century Code, relating to the state board of water well contractors and geothermal system

6 installers and installation.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
9 amended and reenacted as follows:

43-35-03. State board of water well contractors - Members' appointment -

11 Qualification. The state board of water well contractors consists of the state engineer and the

12 state health officer, or their duly authorized designees, and two water well contractors

13 appointed by the governor, and one geothermal system installer appointed by the governor,

one water well pump and pitless unit installer appointed by the governor, and one memberappointed at large by the governor.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

43-35-06. Secretary-treasurer bond. Promptly upon assuming the office, the
secretary-treasurer shall furnish a bond satisfactory to the board for the faithful performance
and discharge of the secretary-treasurer's duties in such an amount as may be prescribed
determined by the board, the premium therefor for which is to be paid from board funds.
SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is

23 amended and reenacted as follows:

43-35-11. Certificate required. No <u>A</u> person, partnership, firm, corporation, or limited
liability company shall <u>may not</u> engage in the business of water well contracting or water well
pump and pitless unit installation, <u>monitoring well contracting</u>, or geothermal system installation
unless certified to do so by the board of water well contractors.

5 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **43-35-12.** Examination - When held - Notice. The board shall hold meetings at such 8 times and such places as it shall designate for the purpose of administering an examination to 9 those persons desiring to become certified as water well contractors, water well pump and 10 pitless unit installers, or monitoring well contractors, or geothermal system installers. The 11 board shall give no less than ten days' written notice to each applicant of the time and place of 12 such examination. The board shall develop separate examinations for the certification of water 13 well contractors, water well pump and pitless unit installers, and monitoring well contractors, 14 and geothermal system installers.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

17 **43-35-13.** Certificate - How obtained - Fee - Bond.

- 181.Any person desiring to take who takes the examination to become a certified water19well contractor shall must first have completed complete a minimum of one-year20apprenticeship or experience in water well drilling and construction under the direct21supervision of a certified water well contractor or have completed a career and22technical education program of at least one year in water well construction and23shall make application to the board.
- 2. Any person desiring to take who takes the examination to become a certified water
   well pump and pitless unit installer shall must first have completed complete a
   minimum of one-year apprenticeship or experience in water well pump and pitless
   unit installation under the direct supervision of a certified water well pump and
   pitless unit installer or have completed a career and technical education program of
   at least one year in water well pump and pitless unit installation.
- 30 <u>3.</u> Any person desiring to take who takes the examination to become a certified
   31 monitoring well contractor shall must first have completed complete a minimum of

one-year apprenticeship or experience in monitoring well construction under the
 direct supervision of a certified water well contractor or a certified monitoring well
 contractor or have completed a career and technical education program of at least
 one year in water well construction or hold a bachelor's degree in engineering or
 geology from an approved school and shall make application to the board.

- 64.Any person who takes the examination to become a certified geothermal system7installer must first complete either a minimum of one year of apprenticeship under8the direct supervision of a certified geothermal system installer or have a minimum9of one year of experience in geothermal system installation working under the10direct supervision of a certified geothermal system installer, or, in the alternative,11must first complete career and technical education relating to geothermal system12installation lasting at least one school year.
- 13 A person applying to take a certification examination shall pay to the board 5. 14 treasurer a nonrefundable examination fee in the amount of ten dollars. If upon 15 examination the applicant is found to be qualified as a water well contractor or, a 16 water well pump and pitless unit installer, a monitoring well contractor, or a 17 geothermal system installer, the board shall issue to that person an appropriate 18 certificate upon the applicant's executing and filing with the board a bond as 19 required in this chapter. The board may offer a combined examination for 20 certification of a person as a water well contractor and a water well pump and 21 pitless unit installer and may issue a single certificate for successful completion of 22 the combined examination. Certificates issued under this chapter are not 23 transferable.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

43-35-14. Bond required. Before receiving a certificate under this chapter, a qualified
applicant shall execute and deposit with the board a surety bond in the amount of two thousand
dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of all water well, monitoring well, or pump and
pitless unit, or geothermal system installation contracts undertaken by the applicant and the
strict compliance with this chapter.

SECTION 7. Section 43-35-15.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
 enacted as follows:

3 43-35-15.3. Certification of persons engaged in installation of geothermal 4 systems before certification requirement. Upon application and sworn affidavit and the 5 payment of a registration fee of not more than fifty dollars, as set by the board, the board shall 6 issue an appropriate certificate, without examination, to any person who has been engaged in 7 the business of geothermal system installation as an occupation for at least one year before 8 July 1, 2007, if the application is made before July 1, 2008. 9 SECTION 8. Section 43-35-18.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 10 11 43-35-18.3. Firm engaged in installation of geothermal systems to employ 12 certified installer - Exception. A person may not engage in the business of installing 13 geothermal systems in the state after July 1, 2008, unless a certified installer, who is 14 responsible for the proper installation of the geothermal system, is in charge of the installation. This chapter does not prohibit a person from installing geothermal systems on that person's 15 16 own premises for that person's own use. 17 SECTION 9. Section 43-35-19.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 18 enacted as follows: 19 43-35-19.3. Standards for installation of geothermal systems. All installation of 20 geothermal systems must comply with the rules adopted by the state geologist and the board. 21 SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is 22 amended and reenacted as follows: 23 **43-35-21.** Certification to nonresidents - Reciprocity. To the extent other states 24 providing for the certification of water well contractors, monitoring well contractors, or water well 25 pump and pitless unit installers, or geothermal system installers provide for similar action, the 26 board may grant certification to water well contractors, monitoring well contractors, and water 27 well pump and pitless unit installers, and geothermal system installers certified by other states, 28 upon payment by the applicant of the required fee and the furnishing of a bond as provided by 29 section 43-35-14, after being furnished with proof that the qualifications of the applicant are

30 equal to the qualifications of holders of such certificates in this state.

SECTION 11. AMENDMENT. Section 43-35-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 43-35-22. Contracting without certification Penalty. Any person contracting to drill
  a water well or monitoring well <del>or</del>, install a pump or pitless unit, or install a geothermal system
  for another without being certified in accordance with this chapter, or otherwise violating this
- 6 chapter, is guilty of an infraction.
