- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 54-52.1-03.2(1) and 54-52.1-03.3(2) of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the retiree health benefits fund.

## 3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

## 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-52.1-03.2(1) is amended:

5 1. The board shall establish a retiree health benefits fund account with the Bank of 6 North Dakota for the purpose of prefunding and providing hospital benefits 7 coverage and medical benefits coverage under the uniform group insurance 8 program for retired eligible employees or surviving spouses of retired eligible 9 employees and their dependents as provided in this chapter. The state shall 10 contribute monthly to the retiree health benefits fund an amount equal to one and 11 fifteen hundredths percent of the monthly salaries and wages of all participating 12 members of the highway patrolmen's retirement system under chapter 39-03.1, 13 and one and fifteen hundredths percent of the monthly salaries of all supreme or 14 district court judges who are participating members of the public employees 15 retirement system under chapter 54-52. Each governmental unit that contributes to 16 the public employees retirement system fund under section 54-52-06 or the 17 retirement plan under chapter 54-52.6 shall contribute monthly to the retiree health 18 benefits fund an amount equal to one and fifteen hundredths percent of the 19 monthly salaries or wages of all participating members of the public employees 20 retirement system under chapter 54-52 or chapter 54-52.6, except for nonteaching 21 employees of the superintendent of public instruction who elect to participate in the 22 public employees retirement system pursuant to section 54-52-02.13 and 23 employees of the state board for career and technical education who elect to 24 participate in the public employees retirement system pursuant to section

1 54-52-02.14. For nonteaching employees of the superintendent of public 2 instruction who elect to participate in the public employees retirement system 3 pursuant to section 54-52-02.13, the superintendent of public instruction shall 4 contribute monthly to the retiree health benefits fund an amount equal to three and 5 one-tenth one-quarter percent of the monthly salaries or wages of those 6 nonteaching employee members, beginning on the first of the month following the 7 transfer under section 54-52-02.13 and continuing thereafter for a period of eight 8 years, after which time the superintendent of public instruction shall contribute one 9 and fifteen hundredths percent of the monthly salary or wages of those 10 nonteaching employee members. For employees of the state board for career and 11 technical education who elect to participate in the public employees retirement 12 system pursuant to section 54-52-02.14, the state board for career and technical 13 education shall contribute monthly to the retiree health benefits fund an amount 14 equal to two and eighty five hundredths three percent of the monthly salary or 15 wages of those employee members, beginning on the first of the month following 16 the transfer under section 54-52-02.14 and continuing thereafter for a period of 17 eight years, after which time the state board for career and technical education 18 shall contribute one and fifteen hundredths percent of the monthly salary or wages 19 of those employee members. The employer of a national guard security officer or 20 firefighter shall contribute monthly to the retiree health benefits fund an amount 21 equal to one and fifteen hundredths percent of the monthly salaries or wages of all 22 national guard security officers or firefighters participating in the public employees 23 retirement system under chapter 54-52. Job service North Dakota shall reimburse 24 monthly the retiree health benefits fund for credit received under section 25 54-52.1-03.3 by members of the retirement program established by job service 26 North Dakota under section 52-11-01. The board, as trustee of the fund and in 27 exclusive control of its administration, shall:

a. Provide for the investment and disbursement of moneys of the retiree health
benefits fund and administrative expenditures in the same manner as moneys
of the public employees retirement system are invested, disbursed, or
expended.

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b. Adopt rules necessary for the proper administration of the retiree health benefits fund, including enrollment procedures.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-52.1-03.3(2) is amended:

4 2. The board shall calculate the allowable monthly credit toward hospital and medical 5 benefits coverage for a person eligible under subsection 1 in an amount equal to 6 four five dollars and fifty cents multiplied by the member's or deceased member's 7 number of years of credited service under the highway patrolmen's retirement 8 system, the public employees retirement system, the retirement program 9 established by job service North Dakota under section 52-11-01, or the judges' 10 retirement program established under chapter 27-17. For a member of the public 11 employees retirement system receiving an early retirement benefit or the surviving 12 spouse of that member, or a former participating member of the defined 13 contribution retirement plan who is receiving a periodic distribution and would not 14 meet the normal retirement provisions of the public employees retirement system, 15 the allowable monthly credit must be reduced by three percent if the member 16 terminates employment within one year prior to attaining the age of sixty-five and 17 an additional reduction factor of six percent shall apply for each year the member 18 terminates employment prior to attaining the age of sixty-four. For a member of the 19 highway patrolmen's retirement system receiving an early retirement benefit or the 20 surviving spouse of that member, the allowable monthly credit must be reduced by 21 three percent if the member terminates employment within one year prior to 22 attaining the age of fifty-five and an additional reduction factor of six percent shall 23 apply for each year the member terminates employment prior to attaining the age 24 of fifty-four. For a member of the retirement program established by job service 25 North Dakota under section 52-11-01 receiving an early retirement benefit or a 26 discontinued service annuity under the plan provisions of that retirement program 27 or the surviving spouse of that member, the allowable monthly credit must be 28 reduced by three percent if the member terminates employment within one year 29 prior to attaining the age of sixty-five and an additional reduction factor of six 30 percent applies for each year the member terminates employment prior to attaining 31 the age of sixty-four.
