- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15-70-01, 15-70-04, and 15-70-05 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to financial assistance to tribal colleges; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-70-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **15-70-01. Definitions.** In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 8 1. "Nonbeneficiary student" means a resident of North Dakota who is enrolled in a
 9 tribally controlled community college but is not an enrolled member of a federally
 10 recognized Indian tribe <u>nor a biological child of a member, living or deceased, of an</u>
 11 Indian tribe.
- "Tribally controlled community college" means an institution of higher education in
 this state which is formally controlled or has been formally sanctioned or chartered
 by the governing body of an Indian tribe, or any combination of federally
 recognized Indian tribes.
- 16 <u>3.</u> Full-time equivalent basis is equal to twenty-four credit-hours per year in which a
 17 <u>nonbeneficiary student is enrolled.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15-70-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 19 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15-70-04. Submission of grant application Distribution of grants. In order to
 qualify for a grant under this chapter, an institution shall submit an application in the manner
 required by the state board of higher education. The application must include documentation of
 the enrollment status of each student on whose account financial assistance under this chapter
 is sought. If an application is approved, the board shall distribute to each tribally controlled

- 1 community college, during each year of the biennium, four thousand five hundred eighty-one
- 2 five thousand three hundred four dollars for each nonbeneficiary student on a full-time
- 3 equivalent basis. If the amount appropriated is insufficient, the board shall distribute a prorated
- 4 amount per nonbeneficiary student on a full-time equivalent basis.
- 5 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-70-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 15-70-05. Reporting by recipient institutions. Each institution receiving a grant
8 under this chapter shall annually provide to the state board of higher education annually, the
9 <u>following information:</u>

- 10 <u>1.</u> <u>To the budget section of the legislative council,</u> an accurate and detailed account
- of the expenditures of the grant funds received by the institution under this chapter
 in a manner specified by the budget section; and
- <u>To the legislative audit and fiscal review committee</u>, a copy of the institution's latest
 audit report and documentation of the enrollment status and ethnic status of each
 student on whose account financial assistance under this chapter is sought.
- 16 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
