## FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sens. Potter, Hacker, Nelson and Reps. Delmore, Ekstrom, N. Johnson introduced:

**SB 2138:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 23-07-07.5 and section 23-07-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to sexual offense medical testing; and to repeal section 12.1-20-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an individual's living arrangements.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Flakoll, Taylor, Wanzek and Reps. D. Johnson, Kingsbury, Mueller introduced:

**SB 2139:** A BILL for an Act to require the legislative council to study laws relating to agriculture.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sen. Hacker and Rep. R. Kelsch introduced:

**SB 2140:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 53-06.1-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to raffle prizes; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Urlacher, Erbele, O'Connell and Reps. Brandenburg, Kretschmar, S. Meyer introduced:

**SB 2141:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 57-39.2-04.2 and 57-40.2-04.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a sales and use tax exemption for materials used to construct a waste heat electric generation facility; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Nelson, Dever, Horne and Reps. Amerman, Froseth, Schneider introduced:

**SB 2142:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 37-14-04, 37-14-06, and 37-14-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to loans made from the veterans' aid fund.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee**.

**FIRST READING OF SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Sens. Seymour, Heitkamp, Wardner and Reps. Boucher, Headland, Thorpe introduced:

**SCR 4001:** A concurrent resolution urging the President and Congress to make the nation's outer continental shelf available for energy development in an environmentally responsible manner.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

The Senate stood adjourned pursuant to Senator Christmann's motion.
