**SB 2176:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 6-03-02.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to parity of state and national bank powers; to amend and reenact sections 6-01-01 and 6-03-38 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the exclusivity of state regulation of financial institutions and credit unions and the uses of bank assets; and to provide a penalty.

**SB 2177:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 5-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the penalty for unlawful delivery of alcohol to certain persons.

Sens. Bowman, Lyson, O'Connell and Reps. S. Meyer, Skarphol introduced:

**SB 2178:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 57-51-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an apportionment of oil and gas gross production tax revenues; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the Finance and Taxation Committee.

Sens. Krebsbach, Dever, Warner and Reps. Hawken, Kaldor, Nelson introduced:

**SB 2181:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 14-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to consent for certain health care services provided to minors.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee.** 

Sens. Nelson, Hacker, Heitkamp and Reps. Delmore, Dosch, Ruby introduced:

**SB 2182:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 6-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to bank operations in the case of an epidemic or other emergency.

**SB 2183:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 18-05.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to establishing a firefighters death benefit fund; to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 26.1-03-17 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to establishing a firefighters death benefit fund; and to provide an appropriation.

Was read the first time and referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Sens. Wardner, Krebsbach, Mathern and Reps. Gulleson, Hawken, Martinson introduced:

**SB 2186:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-11.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to early childhood care workforce development and department of human services establishment of a quality improvement rating system for early childhood care facilities.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Human Services Committee**.

Sens. Wardner, Kilzer, Mathern and Reps. Charging, Dahl, Williams introduced:

**SB 2187:** A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for providing funding to emergency shelter programs and for providing funding for planning administrative costs associated with the housing and urban development's continuum of care homeless assistance program.

Was read the first time and referred to the Human Services Committee.

Sens. Fischer, Cook, Robinson and Reps. Haas, R. Kelsch, Wolf introduced:

**SB 2188:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact four new sections to chapter 49-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to railroad safety and risk assessments.

Was read the first time and referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Was read the first time and referred to the Industry, Business and Labor Committee.

Sens. Nething, Dever, Robinson and Reps. Delmore, Porter, Weiler introduced:

**SB 2189:** A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for state employee salary equity adjustments; to provide a statement of legislative intent regarding state employee compensation adjustments; and to provide a statement of legislative intent regarding state employee health insurance premiums.

Was read the first time and referred to the Appropriations Committee.

Sens. Nelson, Krebsbach, Potter and Reps. Haas, Pietsch, Potter introduced:

**SB 2190:** A BILL for an Act to provide for signage regarding wheelchair availability at state parks and historic sites.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

**SCR 4006:** A concurrent resolution urging Congress to require the United States Department of Veterans' Affairs assume all health care and pharmaceutical needs of veterans in state veterans homes.

Sens. Taylor, Erbele, Flakoll and Reps. DeKrey, Gulleson, Onstad introduced:

**SCR 4007:** A concurrent resolution urging Congress to provide adequate funding for state meat and poultry inspection programs and to enact legislation that allows federally approved state programs to ship state-inspected products interstate.
