- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-02-27.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to city governing body authority to adopt a standard of valuation of less than true and
- 3 full value for property tax purposes for certain vacant lots; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 57-02-27.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **57-02-27.1. Property to be valued at true and full value.** Beginning with the year
- 8 1981, all assessors and boards of equalization shall place the values of all items of taxable
- 9 property at the true and full value of the property except as otherwise specifically provided by
- 10 law, and the amount of taxes that may be levied on such property for the year 1981 and each
- 11 year thereafter must be limited as provided in this chapter. For the purposes of sections
- 12 57-02-27, 57-02-27.1, 57-02-27.2, and 57-55-04, the term "true and full value" has the same
- meaning as provided in subsection 15 of section 57-02-01, except that "true and full value" of
- 14 agricultural lands must be as determined pursuant to section 57-02-27.2.
- The governing body of the city may adopt a standard of valuation of less than true and
- 16 full value for vacant lots that are part of property being developed which has not been sold by
- 17 the developer.
- 18 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
- 19 December 31, 2006.
