- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to publication of false information in political advertisements; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 16.1-10-04. Publication of false information in political advertisements Penalty.
- 7 No A person may is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if that person knowingly sponsor, or with
- 8 reckless disregard for its truth or falsity, publishes any political advertisement or news release
- 9 that contains any assertion, representation, or statement of fact, including information
- 10 concerning a candidate's prior public record, which the sponsor knows to be is untrue,
- 11 deceptive, or misleading, whether on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public
- 12 office, initiated measure, referred measure, constitutional amendment, or any other issue,
- 13 question, or proposal on an election ballot, and whether such the publication is by radio,
- 14 television, newspaper, pamphlet, folder, display cards, signs, posters, et billboard
- 15 advertisements, electronic transmission, or by any other public means. Any person who
- 16 violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor This section does not
- 17 apply to a newspaper, television or radio station, or other commercial medium that is not the
- 18 source of the political advertisement or news release.
