1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-29-12 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to school district tuition payments.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-29-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

15.1-29-12. Tuition payments - Determination.

- Except as provided in section 15.1-29-13, a school district sending a student to
 another district for purposes of education shall pay the full cost of education per
 <u>student</u> incurred by the admitting district.
- 2. a. The admitting district shall determine the cost of education per student for its
 kindergarten, elementary, and high school students on the basis of its
 average daily membership and those expenditures permitted in determining
 the cost of education per student in section 15.1-27-03.
- 14b.To the cost of education per student, the admitting district shall add the latest15available statewide average per student cost for extracurricular activities and16the state average capital outlay per student. The state average capital outlay17per student is determined by dividing the total of all school districts' annual18expenditures for sinking and interest funds, tax receipts to the building funds,19and general fund expenditures for capital outlay by the average daily20membership of the state.
- c. The admitting district shall subtract the following from the amount arrived atunder subdivision b:
- 23 (1) The weighted per student payment received by the admitting district,
 24 less the average amount per North Dakota resident student enrolled in

3			(2)	Any credit for taxes paid to the admitting district by the student's parent.
4		d.	The	amount remaining is the full cost of education per student incurred by the
5		admitting district and the. The tuition amount payable for the individual		
6		student is the lesser of:		
7			<u>(1)</u>	The full cost of education per student incurred by the admitting district;
8				<u>or</u>
9			<u>(2)</u>	One hundred fifty percent of the state average full cost of education per
10				student.
11	<u>3.</u>	This chapter section does not affect the right of a school board to charge and		
12		collect tuition from students who are not residents of this state, in accordance with		
13		section 15.1-29-02.
