1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a biomass energy center.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Biomass energy center. The biomass energy center consists of a

multidisciplinary group led by North Dakota state university research and extension faculty to

research biomass production, harvesting, and transportation to conversion facilities.

SECTION 2. Biomass research responsibilities.

1. North Dakota state university and United States department of agriculture

- North Dakota state university and United States department of agriculture
 researchers shall complete agronomic research to determine the most efficient
 perennial grasses for cellulose production and the amount of fertilization required.
- The North Dakota state university agricultural and biosystems engineering department shall conduct research to determine the most efficient method of harvesting biomass.
- 3. The North Dakota state university agribusiness and applied economics department shall determine the benefits of biomass densification or preprocessing and the agricultural and biosystems department shall research densification or preprocessing technologies.
- 4. The North Dakota state university agribusiness and applied economics department shall complete an economic evaluation of all steps in the utilization of biomass for energy.

SECTION 3. <u>Public information activities.</u> The biomass energy center shall inform the public of the importance of biomass for energy for production. The North Dakota state university extension service shall provide this educational programming. The North Dakota state university extension service is authorized one additional full-time equivalent position to perform this function.

SECTION 4. Ethanol and biomass incentives. The biomass energy center shall
work to expand incentives for cellulosic ethanol production and biomass energy through the
legislative assembly or at the federal level. The center shall identify incentives for producers,
such as providing payment for producers to grow a dedicated bio-energy crop or support
equipment, harvesting, and transportation costs. Biomass energy task force members shall
work through the North Dakota renewable energy partnership to actively promote biomass use.
SECTION 5. Funding. The North Dakota natural resources trust and North Dakota
state university researchers shall seek funding to continue perennial biomass production
research and education at North Dakota state university agricultural research centers and the
United States department of agriculture-agriculture research service station at Mandan.
