- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 6-09.17-01, 6-09.17-02, 6-09.17-03, and
- 2 6-09.17-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the biofuel partnership in assisting
- 3 community expansion fund; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 6-09.17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

6-09.17-01. Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise
requires:

9 1. "Biodiesel production facility" means an individual or organization involved in 10 production of a biodegradable, combustible liquid fuel that is derived from 11 vegetable oil or animal fat and which is suitable for blending with diesel fuel for use 12 in internal combustion diesel engines. The facility must be located in this state and 13 must be owned by at least ten percent agriculture producers or by at least fifty 14 percent residents of this state. 15 "Biodiesel Biofuel partnership in assisting community expansion fund" or "fund" 2. 16 means a fund established to buy down the interest rate on loans to biodiesel and 17 ethanol production facilities and to livestock operations as provided under this 18 chapter. 19 "Biodiesel production facility" means a corporation, limited liability company, 2. 20 partnership, individual, or association involved in production of diesel fuel 21 containing at least five percent biodiesel meeting the specifications adopted by the 22 American society for testing and materials. 23 3. "Community" means the city or county in which an eligible biodiesel production 24 facility is located, or a local development corporation, community organization, or

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1		any other group whose interest is in the economic growth of the area. "Ethanol					
2		production facility" means an individual or organization involved in production of					
3		agriculturally derived denatured ethanol that is suitable for blending with a					
4		petroleum product for use in internal combustion engines. The facility must be					
5		located in this state and must be owned by at least ten percent agriculture					
6		producers or by at least fifty percent residents of this state.					
7	<u>4.</u>	"Livestock operation" means a livestock feeding, handling, milking, or holding					
8		operation located in this state which uses as part of its operation a byproduct					
9		produced at a biodiesel or an ethanol production facility.					
10	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 6-09.17-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is						
11	amended and reenacted as follows:						
12	6-09	0.17-02. Biodiesel Biofuel partnership in assisting community expansion fund					
13	- Continuing appropriation - Administration. A Effective July 1, 2007, the biodiesel						
14	partnership in assisting community expansion fund is hereby established becomes the biofuel						
15	partnership in assisting community expansion fund. All moneys transferred into the fund,						
16	interest on fund moneys, and payments to the fund are hereby appropriated for the purposes of						
17	this chapter. This fund is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended and						
18	unobligated balance in the fund at the end of the biennium must be transferred to the state						
19	general fund. The Bank of North Dakota shall administer the fund. Notwithstanding any other						
20	provision of law, the Bank may transfer any unobligated funds between funds that have been						
21	appropriated by the legislative assembly for interest buydown in the biofuel partnership in						
22	assisting community expansion fund and the partnership in assisting community expansion						
23	<u>fund.</u>						
24	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 6-09.17-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is					
25	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:					
26	6-09	9.17-03. Fund - Purpose - Interest rate buydown. Moneys in the biodiesel					
27	partnership	in assisting community expansion fund must be used for the purpose of buying					
28	down the interest rate on loans made by a lead financial institution in participation with the Bank						
29	of North Dakota. The Bank of North Dakota's participation may not exceed eighty percent nor						
30	be less thar	n fifty percent of the total loans. If the loan is approved by the lenders and there is					

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1	evidence of the community's commitment and ability to fund its portion of the buydown, the						
2	fund's pa	artici	patio	n in tl	ne buydown must automatically be approved.

5		thousand dollars per loan. The maximum amount from the fund in the interest rate
6		buydown for a livestock operation may not exceed two hundred fifty thousand
7		dollars to any single livestock operation under this chapter.
8	<u>3.</u>	The fund participation must be is limited to the amount required to buy down the
9		interest to five hundred basis points below the national prime interest rate.
10	5. <u>4.</u>	The Bank of North Dakota shall adopt rules to implement this chapter.
