- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 6 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the creation of a medical provider partnership in assisting community
- 3 expansion fund loan program; to provide a transfer; and to provide an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new chapter to title 6 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and 6 enacted as follows:

Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

- "Community" means the city or county with a population of fewer than twenty
 thousand in which an eligible medical provider is located, or a local development
 corporation, community organization, or any other group whose interest is in the
- 11 economic growth of the area.
- 12 <u>2.</u> <u>"Medical provider" means a rural hospital or a primary care family practice or</u>
- 13 internal medicine physician, nurse practitioner, or dentist in a stand-alone clinic
 14 setting.
- 153."Medical provider partnership in assisting community expansion fund" or "fund"16means a fund established to buy down the interest rate on loans to medical
- 17 providers as provided under this chapter.
- 18 Medical provider partnership in assisting community expansion fund -

19 Continuing appropriation - Administration. A medical provider partnership in assisting

- 20 community expansion fund is established. All moneys transferred into the fund, interest on
- 21 fund moneys, and payments to the fund are appropriated for the purposes of this chapter. This

22 fund is subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended and unobligated balance in the fund

- 23 at the end of the biennium must be transferred to the state general fund. The Bank of North
- 24 Dakota shall administer the fund.

1	<u>Fun</u>	d - Purpose - Interest rate buydown. Moneys in the medical provider partnership
2	in assisting community expansion fund must be used for the purpose of buying down the	
3	interest rate	on loans made by a lead financial institution in participation with the Bank of North
4	Dakota. Th	e Bank of North Dakota's participation may not exceed eighty percent nor be less
5	<u>than fifty pe</u>	rcent of the total loans. If the loan is approved by the lenders and there is evidence
6	of the comm	nunity's commitment and ability to fund its portion of the buydown, the fund's
7	participation in the buydown must automatically be approved.	
8	Fund moneys use.	
9	<u>1.</u>	The fund moneys may be used to participate in an interest rate buydown on a loan
10		to a medical provider for the purchase of equipment.
11	<u>2.</u>	The community shall determine the amount of the interest rate buydown and apply
12		to the Bank of North Dakota for participation from the medical provider partnership
13		in assisting community expansion fund. The funds for the community's portion of
14		the buydown may come from a local development corporation, contributions,
15		community funds, future dedicated tax programs, or any other community source.
16	<u>3.</u>	The fund participation portion in the buydown must be determined by the Bank of
17		North Dakota based on economic conditions in the city or county in which the
18		medical provider is located.
19	<u>4.</u>	The maximum amount from the fund in the interest rate buydown may not exceed
20		two hundred fifty thousand dollars per loan and not more than one loan may be
21		provided to any single medical provider under this chapter. The community funds
22		required for participation in the interest rate buydown are limited to the amount
23		required when the fund provides two hundred fifty thousand dollars per loan. The
24		fund participation must be limited to the amount required to buy down the interest
25		to five hundred basis points below the national prime interest rate.
26	<u>5.</u>	The Bank of North Dakota shall adopt rules to implement this chapter.
27	SEC	TION 2. TRANSFER. The Bank of North Dakota shall transfer the funds
28	appropriated	d by section 3 of this Act to the medical provider partnership in assisting community
29	expansion fund. The Bank of North Dakota may not be construed to be a general fund agency	
30	because of the appropriation made by section 3 of this Act.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,000,000, or so
 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the Bank of North Dakota for the purposes of
 section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.
