- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to establishing a North Dakota hunter educators association antelope
- 3 license raffle.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 20.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

## Governor's proclamation concerning the hunting of antelope - North Dakota

7 8 hunter educators association raffle. By proclamation, the governor may make available to 9 the North Dakota hunter educators association one license per year to hunt antelope in the 10 manner, places, and times as the governor prescribes. The North Dakota hunter educators 11 association shall hold a raffle under rules adopted by the director. Only residents are eligible to 12 participate. No more than ten percent of the gross proceeds of the raffle may be used to 13 promote the raffle and all net proceeds of the raffle must be used for sponsoring mentored 14 hunts for youth who may otherwise not have the means to go afield to hunt; establishing a statewide network of shooting locations for youth to become familiar with archery equipment 15 16 and firearms under the supervision of a certified volunteer hunter education instructor; and 17 purchasing advertising in news media during hunting season concerning firearms safety and hunting ethics and the promotion of safe and responsible hunting. If an individual receives an 18 19 antelope license through the raffle, the individual is not eligible to apply for an antelope license through the game and fish department that year. The North Dakota hunter educators 20 21 association shall submit reports concerning the raffle as the director requires.
