4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 1 and 4 of section 54-17.6-05 of the North 5 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows: 6 The oil and gas research council is composed of seven eight members, four of 1. 7 whom must currently be engaged in and have at least five years of active 8 experience in the oil and natural gas exploration and production industry. The council consists of: 9 10 Four members appointed by the governor from a list provided by the North 11 Dakota petroleum council. The governor may reject the list and request the 12 council to submit a new list until the appointments are made. 13 One member appointed by the governor from a list provided by the North b. 14 Dakota association of oil and gas producing counties. The governor may 15 reject the list and request the association to submit a new list until the 16 appointment is made. 17 C. The executive director of the North Dakota petroleum council, or the 18 executive director's designee. 19 d. The president of the northern alliance of independent producers or the 20 president's designee. 21 A county commissioner from an oil producing county appointed by the e. 22 governor.
