- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 65-02-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the workforce safety and insurance board membership; and to provide for application
- 3 and transition.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 65-02-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 **65-02-03.1.** Workforce safety and insurance board of directors Appointment.
- The board consists of eleven members. The appointment and replacement of the
  members must ensure that:
- 10 Six board members represent employers in this state which maintain active a. 11 accounts with the organization, at least one of which must be a participant in 12 the risk management program, at least two. Two of which the employer 13 members must be employers with annual premiums, which at the time of the 14 member's initial appointment were greater than twenty-five thousand dollars, 15 at least; one of which the employer members must be an employer with an 16 annual premium of, which at the time of the member's initial appointment was 17 at least ten thousand dollars but less than twenty-five thousand dollars, at 18 least; one of which the employer members must be an employer with an 19 annual premium of, which at the time of the member's initial appointment was 20 less than ten thousand dollars; and at least one two of the employer 21 members must be employer at-large representative representatives. Except 22 for the employer at-large representative representatives, each employer 23 representative must be a principal owner, chief executive officer, or chief 24 financial officer of the employer.

13		offic	ce became effective January 1, 2003, expires on December 31, 2006. The
14		gov	ernor shall make the necessary appointments to ensure the term of office of
15		mer	mbers begins on January first of each odd-numbered year. Board members
16		who	ose initial appointment was before August 1, 2007, may not serve more than

18		<u>July</u>	v 31, 2007, may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
19		<u>a.</u>	A departing member representing an employer must be replaced by a
20			member representing an employer, most of whose employees are in a
21			different rate classification than those of the employer represented by the
22			departing member. The governor shall appoint the replacement member for
23			a departing an employer representative or medical association representative
24			from a list of three potential candidates submitted by the board. The board
25			shall interview an employer representative or a medical representative before
26			placing that candidate's name on the list of replacement member candidates
27			submitted to the governor a coordinating committee appointed by the
28			governor, composed of representatives from the associated general
29			contractors of North Dakota, the North Dakota petroleum council, the greater
30			North Dakota chamber of commerce, the North Dakota motor carriers
31			association, the North Dakota healthcare association, the national federation

9			nonorganized labor employee representative. The governor shall appoint the			
10			replacement member for representatives and the member at large from a list			
11			of three candidates submitted by the board.			
12		<u>d.</u>	The governor shall select the member representing the North Dakota medical			
13			association from a list of three potential candidates submitted by the North			
14			Dakota medical association.

17	17 SECTION 2. APPLICATION AND TRANSITION. This Act applies to all board member					
18	8 appointments occurring after July 31, 2007. The board member serving on August 1, 2007, as					
19	9 the representative of the risk management program shall serve the remainder of the appointed					
20	term as the employer at-large representative. The employee board member serving on					
21	August 1, 2007, as the employee who has received workforce safety and insurance benefits					
22	shall continue to serve through the expiration of the member's appointed term, regardless of the					
23	member's wage-loss benefit history.
