- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an emergency municipal drinking water grant program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

 6 Emergency municipal drinking water grant program. The commission may
- 7 <u>establish an emergency municipal drinking water grant program. The program must be</u>
- 8 designed to provide funds, which may be provided in the form of grants, for municipalities;
- 9 whose primary source of water is the Missouri River, Lake Sakakawea, or Lake Oahe; which
- 10 are unable to supply an adequate quantity of quality water to their municipal water systems as
- 11 a result of low water in the Missouri River system; and which request assistance. The program
- 12 becomes active when the level of Lake Sakakawea reaches one thousand eight hundred four
- 13 feet mean sea level. The program must be designed to provide emergency funds to
- 14 municipalities facing a critical need or health risk as a result of the inability of the water intake
- 15 system for the municipal water system to supply an adequate quantity of quality water to the
- 16 municipal water system.
