1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 7, 8, 34, 35, and 50 of section 20.1-03-12
2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident fishing license fees.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 7, 8, 34, 35, and 50 of section 20.1-03-12 of
5 the North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

6 7. For a nonresident fishing license, thirty-five dollars or the amount a resident of
7 North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident for a
8 nonresident fishing license, whichever is higher.

9 8. For a nonresident short-term seven-day fishing license, twenty dollars or the
10 amount a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the
11 nonresident for a nonresident short-term seven-day fishing license or similar
12 license, whichever is higher.

13 34. For a nonresident husband and wife fishing license, forty-five dollars or the amount
14 a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident
15 for a nonresident husband and wife fishing license or similar license, whichever is
16 higher.

17 35. For a nonresident short-term three-day fishing license, fifteen dollars or the amount
18 a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident
19 for a nonresident short-term three-day fishing license or similar license, whichever
20 is higher.

21 50. For a nonresident short-term ten-day fishing license, twenty-five dollars or the
22 amount a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the
23 nonresident for a nonresident short-term ten-day fishing license or similar license,
24 whichever is higher.
