- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 7, 8, 34, 35, and 50 of section 20.1-03-12
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident fishing license fees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 7, 8, 34, 35, and 50 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 7. For a nonresident fishing license, thirty-five dollars or the amount a resident of

 North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident for a

 nonresident fishing license, whichever is higher.
 - 8. For a nonresident short-term seven-day fishing license, twenty dollars or the amount a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident for a nonresident short-term seven-day fishing license or similar license, whichever is higher.
 - 34. For a nonresident husband and wife fishing license, forty-five dollars or the amount a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident for a nonresident husband and wife fishing license or similar license, whichever is higher.
- 17 35. For a nonresident short-term three-day fishing license, fifteen dollars <u>or the amount</u>
 18 <u>a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the nonresident</u>
 19 <u>for a nonresident short-term three-day fishing license or similar license, whichever</u>
 20 <u>is higher.</u>
- 50. For a nonresident short-term ten-day fishing license, twenty-five dollars <u>or the</u>

 amount a resident of North Dakota would be charged by the home state of the

 nonresident for a nonresident short-term ten-day fishing license or similar license,

 whichever is higher.
