1 A BILL for an Act to provide school district transportation grants.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

3 SECTION 1. TRANSPORTATION GRANTS - DISTRIBUTION.

- 1. During each year of the 2007-09 biennium, the superintendent of public instruction shall calculate the payment to which each school district is entitled based on the state transportation formula as it existed on June 30, 2001, except that the superintendent shall provide reimbursement at the rate of:
 - a. Fifty cents per mile for schoolbuses having a capacity of ten or more passengers and transporting students within city limits;
 - One dollar per mile for schoolbuses having a capacity of ten or more passengers and transporting students in rural areas; and
 - c. Sixty cents per mile for vehicles having a capacity of nine or fewer passengers and transporting students in rural areas.
- The superintendent of public instruction shall use the latest available student enrollment count in each school district in applying the provisions of the transportation formula as it existed on June 30, 2001.
- Nothing in this section authorizes the reimbursement of any costs incurred in providing transportation for student attendance at extracurricular activities or events.
