- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the imposition of fees by home rule cities for certain vehicle and traffic
- 3 violations; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 40-05-06 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- a. For Except as otherwise provided under subdivision b, for every violation of a city ordinance regulating that regulates the operation or equipment of a motor vehicles vehicle or regulating which regulates traffic, except those ordinances listed in section 39-06.1-05, a fee may be established, by ordinance, which may not exceed the limits, for equivalent categories of violations, set forth in section 39-06.1-06.
 - b. A home rule city may establish, by ordinance, a fee for the violation of a city ordinance that regulates the operation or equipment of a motor vehicle or which regulates traffic, except those ordinances listed in section 39-06.1-05, which may exceed the limits, for equivalent categories of violations, set forth in section 39-06.1-06. If a home rule city imposes a fee that exceeds two hundred percent of the limits in section 39-06.1-06, the amount that exceeds two hundred percent of that limit must be paid into the treasury of the proper county to be added to the state school fund.
- 21 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
