## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. Tattooing and body piercing Minors Penalty.
  - 1. As used in this section:
    - a. "Tattooing" means the marking of the skin of an individual by insertion of permanent colors through puncture of the skin.
    - b. "Piercing" means the puncturing of any part of an individual's body for the purpose of inserting studs, pins, rings, chains, or other jewelry or adornment.
    - 2. It is a class B misdemeanor for a person to tattoo or pierce an individual who is under eighteen years of age unless the tattooing or piercing takes place in the presence of and with the written consent of the individual's parent or legal guardian.
    - It is a class B misdemeanor for a person to sell, trade, or otherwise provide
      materials or kits for tattooing, self-tattooing, body piercing, or self-body piercing to
      an individual who is under eighteen years of age.
  - 4. A political subdivision may enact and enforce an ordinance restricting tattooing and piercing or restricting the sale of tattooing and piercing materials and kits if the ordinance is equal to or more stringent than this section.
