1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of sections 2 and 5 of article V of the Constitution of

2 North Dakota, relating to the public service commission; to provide for application; and to

- 3 provide an effective date.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

5 This measure replaces the three-member public service commission with a public service

6 commissioner and changes the term of office from six to four years. The measure provides for

7 the next election for public service commissioner to be held in 2012.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

10 That the following proposed amendments to sections 2 and 5 of article V of the 11 Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of 12 North Dakota at the primary election to be held in 2008, in accordance with section 16 of 13 article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 2 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota
is amended and reenacted as follows:

16 **Section 2.** The qualified electors of the state at the times and places of choosing 17 members of the legislative assembly shall choose a governor, lieutenant governor, agriculture 18 commissioner, attorney general, auditor, insurance commissioner, three public service 19 commissioners commissioner, secretary of state, superintendent of public instruction, tax 20 commissioner, and treasurer. The legislative assembly may by law provide for a department of 21 labor to be administered by a public official who may be either elected or appointed. 22 The powers and duties of the agriculture commissioner, attorney general, auditor, 23 insurance commissioner, public service commissioners commissioner, secretary of state,

24 superintendent of public instruction, tax commissioner, and treasurer must be prescribed by

law. If the legislative assembly establishes a labor department, the powers and duties of the
 officer administering that department must be prescribed by law.

3 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota
4 is amended and reenacted as follows:

5 Section 5. The qualified electors shall choose the elected state officials at a time 6 designated by the legislative assembly. The elected state officials shall serve until their 7 successors are duly qualified. Terms of office of the elected officials except the public service 8 commissioners are four years, except that in 2004 the agriculture commissioner, attorney 9 general, secretary of state, and tax commissioner are elected to a term of two years. The terms 10 of the public service commissioners are six years, so arranged that one of them is elected 11 every two years. The terms of the governor and lieutenant governor begin on December 12 fifteenth following their election. 13 If two or more candidates for any executive office other than for governor and lieutenant 14 governor receive an equal and highest number of votes, the legislative assembly in joint 15 session shall choose one of them for the office. 16 **SECTION 3. APPLICATION.** The six-year term for a public service commissioner 17 provided before the effective date of this measure continues until expiration of the respective 18 term. The next election for a public service commissioner must be held in 2012.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. If approved by the voters, this measure becomes
effective July 1, 2008.
