HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3001

Introduced by

Legislative Council

(Budget Section)

1 A concurrent resolution authorizing the Budget Section of the Legislative Council to hold the

2 required legislative hearings on state plans for the receipt and expenditure of new or revised

3 block grants passed by Congress.

4 WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States enacted the Omnibus Budget

5 Reconciliation Act of 1981 creating the community services block grant program; and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly is required to conduct public hearings; and

7 WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committees have met the public hearing requirement for
8 community services block grant moneys expected for the next biennium by the Department of

9 Commerce; and

10 WHEREAS, the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly cannot hold public hearings on revisions

11 to current block grants or additional block grants that may be approved by Congress after the

12 recess or adjournment of the Legislative Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly will not meet in regular session during 2008 and
thus its public hearing responsibility for grants not approved by the Sixtieth Legislative
Assembly must be delegated to a legislative entity;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 17 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Department of Commerce appropriation bill enacted by the Legislative
Assembly is the Legislative Assembly's approval of and contains directions regarding the use of
community services block grant moneys for the period ending September 30, 2009; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Budget Section of the Legislative Council may hold the public legislative hearings required for the receipt of additional block grants or other federal moneys under the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 or other relevant federal statutes; and

Sixtieth Legislative Assembly

- 1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the authority granted by this resolution is in effect
- 2 during the period from the recess or adjournment of the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly through
- 3 September 30, 2009, and the Budget Section may provide public notice and hold the hearings
- 4 authorized by this resolution using the methods and procedures it deems appropriate.
