## 4 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This measure provides that during the term for which a member was elected to the legislative
- 6 assembly, the member of the legislative assembly may be appointed to an office for which the
- 7 compensation has been increased by the legislative assembly if the increase was not a greater
- 8 percentage than any general increase provided for all permanent full-time state employees.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

## 10 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

- 11 That the following proposed amendment to section 6 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 12 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at
- 13 the primary election to be held in 2008, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 14 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 15 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 6 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota
- 16 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- **Section 6.** While serving in the legislative assembly, no member may hold any full-time
- 18 appointive state office established by this constitution or designated by law. During the term for
- 19 which elected, no member of the legislative assembly may be appointed to any full-time office
- 20 which has been created, or to any office for which the compensation has been increased, by
- 21 the legislative assembly during that term by a greater percentage than any general
- 22 compensation increase provided for all permanent full-time state employees.
