5	WHEREAS, the investor-to-state provisions of international trade agreements, such as
6	the North American Free Trade Agreement grant a foreign corporation the ability to sue the
7	federal, state, or a local government if the corporation contends that law or rule impairs the
8	ability of the corporation to make a profit; and
9	WHEREAS, the ability of the federal government and state and local governments to
10	adopt and enforce laws and rules is essential to protect the health, safety, and welfare of
11	citizens; and
12	WHEREAS, a complaint has been filed under the North American Free Trade
13	Agreement by Canadian Cattlemen for Free Trade against the United States Department of
14	Agriculture for loss of profits under rules that prevent Canadian cattle from being imported into
15	the United States because of the threat of mad cow disease; and
16	WHEREAS, three nonelected officials serve as an arbitration tribunal in the
17	investor-to-state cases from which no appeals are permitted; and
18	WHEREAS, monetary awards from the investor-to-state cases significantly impact the
19	taxpayers of this country; and
20	WHEREAS, the fear of investor-to-state lawsuits may dissuade passage and
21	enforcement of laws and implementation of rules that are made in the public interest; and
22	WHEREAS, proposed and future agreements could expand investor-to-state provisions
23	such as those in the North American Free Trade Agreement and the Central America Free
24	Trade Agreement;
