- 1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to repeal the REAL ID Act of 2005.
- 2 WHEREAS, the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 mandates an unfunded national driver's
- 3 license in the state of North Dakota; and
- 4 **WHEREAS**, implementation of the REAL ID Act may cost this state an estimated
- 5 \$14,000,000; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the REAL ID national data base will invite identity theft and invasion of
- 7 privacy; and
- 8 **WHEREAS**, the REAL ID Act will cost and inconvenience the people of North Dakota
- 9 without the proffered attendant benefit of protection from terrorism;
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

11 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 12 That the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
- 13 repeal the REAL ID Act of 2005; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
- 15 resolution to the President of the United States, the Secretary of Homeland Security, the
- 16 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, and to each member of the North Dakota
- 17 Congressional Delegation.
