- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-18-05 and 43-18-24 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to plumbing board member compensation and plumbing code violations;

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-18-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

  43-18-05. Members of board and employees Compensation. Each appointed
- 8 member of the board shall receive twenty fifty dollars per day for each day actually engaged in
- 9 the performance of the member's duties under this chapter, and all members of the board, and
- 10 all employees thereof, shall receive their traveling expenses incurred in the performance of their
- 11 duties. Allowances for traveling expenses must be as provided by law for state officials and
- 12 employees. All such The compensation and expense must be paid out of the state plumbing
- 13 board fund. The compensation provided for in this section may not be paid to any member of
- 14 the board who receives salary or other compensation as a regular employee of the state or any
- 15 of its political subdivisions or any institution or industry operated by the state.
- 16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-18-24 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **43-18-24.** Violation of chapter Penalty. Any person who violates any of the
- 19 provisions of this chapter, rules adopted under this chapter, or ef the state plumbing code, or
- 20 who fails to do any act required by said code, is guilty of an infraction a class B misdemeanor,
- 21 unless a different penalty is otherwise specifically provided.
