- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 53-06.2-01 and two new
- 2 subsections to section 53-06.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition
- 3 of the racing promotion fund and to the duties of the racing commission; and to amend and
- 4 reenact section 53-06.2-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to taxes on parimutuel
- 5 wagering.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 53-06.2-01 of the North Dakota Century 8 Code is created and enacted as follows: 9 "Racing promotion fund" means a fund administered by the commission 10 established to assist in improving and upgrading racetracks in the state, promoting 11 horse racing in the state, and developing new racetracks in the state as necessary 12 and approved by the commission. 13 **SECTION 2.** Two new subsections to section 53-06.2-04 of the North Dakota Century 14 Code are created and enacted as follows: 15 Report biennially to the legislative council regarding the operation of the 16 commission. 17 Provide notice to the North Dakota horsemen's council of meetings held by the 18 commission and permit the North Dakota horsemen's council to participate in the 19 meetings through placement of items on the agenda. 20 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.2-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is 21 amended and reenacted as follows: 22 53-06.2-11. (Effective through June 30, 2007) Bet payoff formulas - Uses by

licensee of funds in excess of expenses - Payment to general fund.

For each day of a live race meet or a simulcast day in this state on win, place, 2 and show parimutuel pools, the licensee shall deduct up to twenty percent of 3 the total win, place, and show pool. On the first eleven million dollars of total 4 wagering handle in each biennium, two percent must be paid to the state 5 treasurer to be deposited in the general fund. One half of one percent must 6 be paid to the North Dakota racing commission to be used for the North 7 Dakota purse fund. One half of one percent must be paid to the North Dakota 8 racing commission to be used for the North Dakota breeders' fund for the 9 respective breed of horses racing at that meet. Breakage must be paid to the 10 North Dakota racing commission to be deposited in the promotion fund. 11 On the wagering handle on win, place, and show wagering pools in excess of b. 12 eleven million dollars in each biennium, one sixteenth of one percent must be 13 paid to the commission to be deposited in the purse fund; one-sixteenth of 14 one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the promotion 15 fund; one sixteenth of one percent must be paid to the commission to be 16 deposited in the breeders' fund; and one sixteenth of one percent must be 17 paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund. 18 For wagering on live horse racing and simulcast wagering: 19 In win, place, and show parimutuel polls, the licensee may deduct no more 20 than twenty percent of the amount wagered. Of the amount wagered, the 21 licensee shall pay: 22 Two percent to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund. (1) 23 (2) One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the 24 breeders' fund. 25 One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the purse (3)26 fund. 27 <u>(4)</u> One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the racing 28 promotion fund. 29 In daily double, quinella, exacta, trifecta, or other combination parimutuel b. 30 pools, the licensee may deduct no more than twenty-five percent of the 31 amount wagered. Of the amount wagered, the licensee shall pay:

1 (1) Two and one-half percent to the state treasurer to be deposited in the 2 general fund. 3 <u>(2)</u> One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the 4 breeders' fund. 5 (3)One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the purse 6 fund. 7 <u>(4)</u> One-half of one percent to the commission to be deposited in the racing 8 promotion fund. 9 2. For each day of a live race meet or a simulcast day in this state for each daily 10 double, quinella, exacta, trifecta, or other wager combining two or more horses for 11 winning payoffs, the licensee shall deduct up to twenty-five percent of each 12 wagering pool. Of each wagering dollar, the amounts to be deposited in the 13 general fund and other funds are as follows: 14 On the first eleven million dollars of wagering handle in each biennium, 15 one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the 16 purse fund; one-half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be 17 deposited in the promotion fund; one-half of one percent must be paid to the 18 commission to be deposited in the breeders' fund; and two and one-half 19 percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general 20 fund. 21 On the wagering handle in excess of eleven million dollars in each biennium, 22 one-sixteenth of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited 23 in the purse fund; one-sixteenth of one percent must be paid to the 24 commission to be deposited in the promotion fund; one sixteenth of one 25 percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the breeders' fund; 26 and one-sixteenth of one percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be 27 deposited in the general fund. 28 For account wagering: 29 In win, place, and show parimutuel pools, the licensee may deduct no more a. 30 than twenty percent of the amount wagered.

 - 4. The licensee conducting a <u>wagering on</u> live race meet or racing, simulcast program wagering, or account wagering shall retain all other money in the parimutuel pool and pay it to bettors holding winning tickets as provided by rules adopted by the commission.
 - 5. A licensee may not use any of the portion deducted for expenses under subsections 1 and 2 for expenses not directly incurred by the licensee in conducting parimutual racing under the certificate system. After paying qualifying expenses, the licensee shall use the remainder of the amount so withheld only for eligible uses allowed to charitable gambling organizations under subsection 2 of section 53 06.1-11 53-06.1-11.1.
 - 6. The racing commission shall deposit the moneys received pursuant to subsections 1, 2, and 3 and from the North Dakota horse racing foundation pursuant to subsection 5 of section 53-06.2-05 in three special funds in the state treasury. These funds must be known as the breeders' fund, the purse fund, and the racing promotion fund. Moneys, and any earnings on the moneys, in the breeders' fund, purse fund, and racing promotion fund are appropriated to the commission on a continuing basis to carry out the purposes of those funds under this chapter and must be administered and disbursed in accordance with rules adopted by the commission. The commission, upon approval of the emergency commission, may receive no more than twenty-five percent of the racing promotion fund for the payment of the commission's operating expenses.

(Effective after June 30, 2007) Bet payoff formulas - Uses by licensee of funds in excess of expenses - Payment to general fund.

1. For each day of a live race meet or a simulcast day in this state on win, place, and show parimutual pools, the licensee shall deduct up to twenty percent of the total win, place, and show pool. One half of one percent must be paid to the North Dakota racing commission to be used for the North Dakota purse fund. One half of one percent must be paid to the North Dakota racing commission to be used for the North Dakota breeders' fund for the respective breed of horses racing at that

meet. On the first thirty-five million five hundred thousand dollars of total wagering handle in each biennium, two percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund. On the total wagering handle in excess of thirty five million five hundred thousand dollars in each biennium, one half of one percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund. For each day of a live race meet or a simulcast day in this state for each daily double, quinella, exacta, trifecta, or other wager combining two or more horses for winning payoffs, the licensee shall deduct up to twenty-five percent of each

general fund and other funds are as follows:

On the first one hundred two million four hundred thousand dollars of wagering handle in each biennium, one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the purse fund; one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the promotion fund; one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the breeders' fund; and two and one half percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund.

On the wagering handle in excess of one hundred two million four hundred thousand dollars in each biennium, one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the purse fund; one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the promotion fund; one half of one percent must be paid to the commission to be deposited in the breeders' fund; and one fourth of one percent must be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund.
- 3. Unclaimed tickets and breakage from each live race meet and simulcast program as defined by the commission and the percentage of the wagering pool to be paid to the racing promotion fund under subsections 1 and 2 must be retained by the commission in a special fund to assist in improving and upgrading racetracks in the state, for the promotion of horse racing within the state, and in developing new racetracks in the state as necessary and approved by the commission.

 Notwithstanding this section, the commission may receive no more than

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- twenty five percent of this fund for the purpose of payment of operating expenses
 of the commission.
 - 4. The licensee conducting a live race meet or simulcast program shall retain all other money in the parimutuel pool and pay it to betters holding winning tickets as provided by rules adopted by the commission.
 - 5. A licensee may not use any of the portion deducted for expenses under subsections 1 and 2 for expenses not directly incurred by the licensee in conducting parimutual racing under the certificate system. After paying qualifying expenses, the licensee shall use the remainder of the amount so withheld only for eligible uses allowed to charitable gambling organizations under subsection 2 of section 53 06.1 11.
 - 6. The racing commission shall deposit the moneys received pursuant to subsections 1, 2, and 3 and from the North Dakota horse racing foundation pursuant to subsection 5 of section 53-06.2-05 in three special funds in the state treasury. These funds must be known as the breeders' fund, the purse fund, and the racing promotion fund. Moneys, and any earnings on the moneys, in the breeders' fund, purse fund, and racing promotion fund are appropriated to the commission on a continuing basis to carry out the purposes of those funds under this chapter and must be administered and disbursed in accordance with rules adopted by the commission.
