BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6	SECTION 1. Interagency agreement between the department of human services
7	and the department of corrections and rehabilitation. The executive director of the
8	department of human services and the director of the department of corrections and
9	rehabilitation shall enter an interagency agreement effective August 1, 2007. The agreement
10	must provide that the department of corrections and rehabilitation is responsible for the
11	provision and enforcement of safety and security procedures at state-owned facilities for all
12	individuals placed at those facilities for evaluation or civil commitment and treatment under
13	chapter 25-03.3 and for all staff, visitors, and volunteers at those facilities. The interagency
14	agreement must provide that the executive director of the department of human services shall
15	continue to be responsible for the custody and care of the individuals placed at those facilities
16	for evaluation or civil commitment and treatment under chapter 25-03.3, including responsibility
17	for all assessments, evaluations, and treatment required under chapter 25-03.3, the provision
18	of all necessary staffing, including maintenance staff, and the provision of all daily care and
19	health care.

- 21 hospital. Before March first of each even-numbered year, the department of human services
- 22 shall report to the legislative council on services provided by the department of corrections and

- 24 and custody of the executive director of the department of human services.
