- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 45-11-01 and section 47-25-02
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to partnership fictitious names and trade names.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 45-11-01 of the North Dakota

  Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 2. Any A partnership transacting may not transact business in this state or obtain any license, permit, or registration under a fictitious name or under a designation that does not show the names of the persons interested as partners must file until it has filed a fictitious name certificate with the secretary of state, together with a filing fee of twenty-five dollars. When a partnership has more than two members, an additional three dollars must be paid for each additional member not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars. A limited partnership or a foreign limited partnership transacting business under a name filed under chapter 45-10.2 and as provided in section 45-11-03 or a partnership transacting business under a name filed under section 45-13-05 is not required to file a fictitious name certificate under this section.
  - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 47-25-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - **47-25-02. Trade name Registration Statement Contents.** A person or organization may not engage in business <u>or obtain a license</u>, <u>permit</u>, <u>or registration</u> in this state under a trade name until the trade name is registered with the secretary of state. This section does not apply to partnerships that have filed a fictitious name certificate as provided under chapter 45-11. The trade name registration must be a statement executed by the owner upon forms prescribed by the secretary of state, setting forth:

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- 1 1. The trade name to be registered;
- 2 2. The name and address of the owner of the business, and if a corporation, limited
- 3 liability company, or other organization, the state or country of incorporation or
- 4 organization;
- 5 3. Address of the principal place of business; and
- 6 4. The nature of the business in detail.
