- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-33-12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to deposit of fees for agricultural export certification services.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-33-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **4-33-12. Authority for domestic and export certification.** The commissioner may
- 7 inspect any plant and plant product, when offered for export or shipment from within the state
- 8 and to certify to shippers and interested parties as to the freedom of such products from
- 9 injurious pests according to the sanitary phytosanitary requirements of other states and foreign
- 10 countries. Authority for inspection and certification under this section is not limited to plants
- 11 defined in section 4-33-01. The commissioner may make reasonable charges and use any
- 12 means necessary to accomplish this objective. A portion of the fees collected may be
- 13 deposited in the commissioner's operating fund equivalent to the amount that the United States
- 14 department of agriculture assesses the department for federal plant export certificates issued
- by the commissioner. A certificate may be withheld or not issued if the product does not meet
- 16 sanitary phytosanitary or import requirements and if all North Dakota licensing and bonding
- 17 requirements have not been met. Consignee names and addresses on phytosanitary
- 18 certificates are confidential.
