## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2109

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 23-09.3-01.1 and subsection 1
- 2 of section 23-16-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the moratorium on
- 3 licensing of basic care for medical assistance recipient beds and the moratorium on expansion
- 4 of long-term care bed capacity; and to declare an emergency.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 23-09.3-01.1 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	1.	Ba	sic care beds may not be added to the state's licensed bed capacity during the
9		<del>pe</del>	riod between August 1, 2005, and July 31, 2007, except when:
10		a.	A nursing facility converts nursing facility beds to basic care; or
11		b.	An entity demonstrates to the state department of health and the department
12			of human services that basic care services are not readily available within a
13			designated area of the state or that existing basic care beds within a fifty-mile
14			radius have been occupied at ninety percent or more for the previous twelve
15			months. In determining whether basic care services will be readily available if
16			an additional license is issued, preference may be given to an entity that
17			agrees to any participation program established by the department of human
18			services for individuals eligible for services under the medical assistance
19			program under title XIX of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.].
20		<u>C.</u>	If the state department of health and the department of human services grant
21			approval of new basic care beds to an entity, the approved entity shall license
22			the beds within forty-eight months from the date of approval.
23	SE	ECTIO	ON 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 23-16-01.1 of the North Dakota
24	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		

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1	1.	Notwithstanding sections 23-16-06 and 23-16-10, except when a facility reverts
2		basic care beds to nursing facility beds, nursing facility beds may not be added to
3		the state's licensed bed capacity <del>during the period between August 1, 2005, and</del>
4		July 31, 2007. A nursing facility may not convert licensed nursing bed capacity to
5		basic care bed capacity or convert basic care beds back to nursing facility beds
6		more than one time in a twelve-month period if the beds have been licensed as
7		basic care.
8	SE	CTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
