1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-14-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to presidential electors.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 16.1-14-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **16.1-14-20.** Application for presidential ballot by new residents. A person desiring 7 to qualify to vote for presidential electors is not required to register but, not less than ten days in 8 advance of the election, shall make an application in the form of an affidavit executed in 9 duplicate in the presence of the county auditor substantially as follows:
