- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to qualifications of electricians.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
  - **43-09-11.** Qualifications as to experience. An applicant for an electrician's license must have the following experience and training:
    - Master electrician, one year's experience as a licensed journeyman electrician. 1.
- 2. Journeyman electrician, four years' eight thousand hours experience in installing 10 and repairing electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment, which experience may 11 not be obtained in less than three years. In addition, an apprentice electrician who 12 registers with the board after August 1, 2007, shall complete apprenticeship 13 training approved by the bureau of apprenticeship and training, United States 14 department of labor, or other training approved by the board.
  - 3. Class B electrician, eighteen months' experience in farmstead or residential wiring.
