1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of agriculture to defray the
2 expenses of farmers market development and promotion.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the department of agriculture for the purpose of expanding the farmers market
8 program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:

9 Salaries and wages	\$208,000
10 Operating expenses	150,000
11 Grants, benefits, and claims	<u>150,000</u>
12 Total all funds	\$508,000
13 Less estimated income	<u>150,000</u>
14 Total general fund appropriation	\$358,000
