1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 35-17-04, 35-30-02, and 35-31-02 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to notification of debtor of agister's lien, agricultural processor's

3 lien, and agricultural supplier's lien.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 35-17-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

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35-17-04. Procedure to obtain lien - Statement filed - Contents - Waiver.

- 8 <u>1.</u> Any person entitled to an agister's lien, within ninety days after taking possession 9 of the animal, may file in the office of the recorder in any county in this state or in 10 the office of the secretary of state, a verified statement containing the following 11 information:
- 12 <u>4.</u> <u>a.</u> The number of and a description of the animals subject to the lien and the
 13 legal description as to the location of the animals.
- 14 2. <u>b.</u> The name and address of the person for whom the animals are kept.
- 15 3. <u>c.</u> The name and address of the lienholder.
- 164.d.The price agreed upon for keeping the animals and, if no price was agreed17upon, the reasonable value of the services.
- 5. <u>e.</u> The social security number or, in the case of a debtor doing business other
 than as an individual, the internal revenue service taxpayer identification
 number of the person for whom the animals are kept.
- 2. The secretary of state and the office of the recorder in any county in this state with
 which a verified statement under subsection 1 is submitted for filing shall reject the
 statement unless the statement is accompanied by proof of mailing of notification

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13.The secretary of state shall prescribe one form that can be used to obtain a lien2under this section or gain protection under the central notice system, or both.3Before a processor's lien is filed, a billing statement for the services performed4must include notice to the agricultural producer that if the amount due to the5agricultural processor is not satisfied a lien may be filed.

6 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 35-31-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

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35-31-02. Procedure to obtain lien.

- 9 To obtain an agricultural supplier's lien, except an agricultural supplier's lien for 1. 10 furnishing petroleum products, the person entitled to the lien, within one hundred 11 twenty days after the supplies are furnished or the services performed, shall file a 12 verified statement in the office of the recorder of any county in this state or in the 13 office of the secretary of state. To obtain an agricultural supplier's lien for 14 furnishing and delivering petroleum products, the person entitled to the lien, within 15 one hundred fifty days after the petroleum products are furnished or delivered, 16 shall file a verified statement in the office of the recorder of any county in the state 17 or in the office of the secretary of state. The statement must contain the following 18 information:
- 19 **1.** <u>a.</u> The name and address of the person to whom the supplies were furnished.
- 20 2. <u>b.</u> The name and address of the supplier.
- 213.c.A description of the crops, agricultural products, or livestock and their amount22or number, if known, subject to the lien together with a reasonable description,23including the county as to the location of the crops, agricultural products, or24livestock and the year the crop is to be harvested or was harvested.

25 4. <u>d.</u> A description and value of the supplies and the first date furnished.

- 26 <u>5.</u> <u>e.</u> The social security number or, in the case of a debtor doing business other
 27 than as an individual, the internal revenue service taxpayer identification
 28 number of the person to whom the supplies were furnished.
- 29 2. The secretary of state and the office of the recorder in any county in this state with
 30 which a verified statement under subsection 1 is submitted for filing shall reject the
 31 statement unless the statement is accompanied by proof of mailing of notification

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1		of the lien to the debtor's last-known address by registered or certified mail with
2		return receipt requested.
3	<u>3.</u>	The secretary of state shall prescribe one form that can be used to obtain a lien
4		under this section or gain protection under the central notice system, or both.
5		Before a supplier's lien is filed, a billing statement for the supplies furnished must
6		include notice to the agricultural producer that if the amount due to the agricultural
7		supplier is not satisfied a lien may be filed.
