- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-20 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to sex offenders on school property; to amend and reenact
- 3 subsection 14 of section 12.1-32-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to sex
- 4 offenders on school property; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12.1-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Sexual offenders on school property. A high-risk sexual offender who is required to

register under section 12.1-32-15 may not enter on the real property comprising a public or

11 with a written policy adopted by the school board of the public elementary, middle, or high

12 school or the governing body of a private elementary, middle, or high school with control over

13 the property. Any other registered sexual offender who is a parent or guardian of a student

14 attending the school may enter designated areas of the school allowed for activities involving

the sexual offender's own child with advance notice and approval of the school board of a

16 <u>public school or governing entity of a private school or if the sexual offender is present for</u>

purposes of voting in a school building used as a public polling place. A sexual offender who

violates this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 14 of section 12.1-32-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

14. A state officer, law enforcement agency, or school district or any appointee, officer, or employee of those entities is not subject to civil or criminal liability for making risk determinations, adopting policies governing or permitting the presence of

- 1 <u>sexual offenders on school property as provided for in chapter 12.1-20,</u> or for
- 2 disclosing or for failing to disclose information as permitted by this section.
