4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-11.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

11-11.1-02. Members of the job development authority board of directors - Term of office - Oath - Expenses - Compensation. The members of the job development authority board of directors and the joint job development authority board of directors shall serve for a term of three years or until their successors are duly qualified. Terms of office begin on January first and must be arranged so that the terms of office of approximately one-third of the members expire on December thirty-first of each year. Each member of the board shall qualify by taking the oath provided for civil officers. The oath must be filed with the county auditor.

The board of directors shall annually elect members to serve as chairman, vice chairman, secretary, and treasurer. The board shall also select an executive committee with such powers and duties as may be delegated by the board. Members may be reimbursed from funds available to the authority for mileage and expenses as provided in sections 44-08-04 and 54-06-09 but may not receive compensation for service. The board of county commissioners may authorize to members payment of a sum not to exceed forty-five dollars per day for time actually spent in transacting the business of the job development authority board, in addition to any salary a member of the board receives from any other source.
