- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to high school coursework requirements; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to high school graduation
- 4 requirements.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code
 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **15.1-21-02.1.** High school coursework graduation requirements. Before a school
- 9 district, a nonpublic high school, or the North Dakota division of independent study issues a
- 10 high school diploma to a student, the student must have successfully completed at least
- 11 twenty-one units of high school coursework from the minimum required curriculum offerings
- 12 established by section 15.1-21-02. Beginning with the 2009-10 school year, the number of
- 13 units required by this section increases to twenty-two and beginning with the 2011-12 school
- 14 year, the number of units required by this section increases to twenty-four.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 16 created and enacted as follows:
