## SENATE BILL NO. 2414

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-38 and a new subsection to
- 2 section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an income tax credit for
- 3 taxpayers who provide home education for their children; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Home education credit. A taxpayer is entitled to a credit against tax liability
- 8 determined under section 57-38-29 or section 57-38-30.3 in the amount of one thousand dollars
- 9 for each dependent of the taxpayer who received home education as defined in section
- 10 <u>15.1-23-01</u> for the entire school year ending in the taxable year if the taxpayer is a North
- 11 Dakota resident and the home education meets the requirements of chapter 15.1-23. The
- 12 amount of the credit under this section is reduced by fifty percent for a dependent child who
- 13 received home education for less than the entire school year, but at least one-half of the school
- 14 year, ending during the taxable year. A credit under this section is not allowed for a dependent
- 15 child who received home education for less than one-half of the school year ending in the
- 16 taxable year.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 18 is created and enacted as follows:
- A taxpayer filing a return under this section is entitled to the credit provided under
- 20 section 1 of this Act.
- 21 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
- 22 December 31, 2006.
