STATEMENT OF INTENT

5 This measure repeals the prohibition that during the term for which a member was elected to

6 the legislative assembly, the member of the legislative assembly may not be appointed to a

7 full-time office that has been created or to an office to which the compensation has been

8 increased by the legislative assembly.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

10 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

11 That the following proposed amendment to section 6 of article IV of the Constitution of 12 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at 13 the primary election to be held in 2008, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the 14 Constitution of North Dakota.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 6 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota
is amended and reenacted as follows:

Section 6. While serving in the legislative assembly, no member may hold any full-time
 appointive state office established by this constitution or designated by law. During the term for
 which elected, no member of the legislative assembly may be appointed to any full-time office
 which has been created, or to any office for which the compensation has been increased, by
 the legislative assembly during that term.
