Allows licensed organizations to conduct poker and poker tournaments on 2 occasions per year per site. The bet limit is increased to \$4 per hand in nontournament events and the organization can collect a rake of up to \$2 per hand.

The bill allows poker tournaments in addition to offering poker games, increases the number of sites that can offer poker or poker tournaments, and increases the poker hand limit by \$3.
