4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-31-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-31-08. Possession or distribution of certain photographs or other visual representations prohibited - Penalty.

- 1. A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if, knowing of its character and content, a that person surreptitiously acquires and knowingly possesses or distributes any photograph or other visual representation that exhibits a nude or partially denuded human figure, as defined in section 12.1-27.1-03.1, without the individual's written consent.
- 2. A person is guilty of a class B misdemeanor if, knowing of its character and content that person acquires and knowingly possesses or distributes any photograph or visual representation that exhibits a nude or partially denuded figure, as defined in section 12.1-27-03.1, without the individual's consent.
- 3. If the photograph or other visual representation is of a minor and possession does not violate section 12.1-27.2-04.1, a parent of the minor may give permission for a person to possess or distribute the photograph or other visual representation.
- 4. This section does not apply to any book, as defined in section 12.1-27.1-03.1, photograph, video recording, motion picture film, or other visual representation sold in the normal course of business through wholesale or retail outlets that possess a valid sales tax permit or used by a licensed attorney, attorney's agent, or any other
