- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative council study of the capitol complex facility needs.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY STATE CAPITOL GROUNDS
- 4 **FACILITY NEEDS.** During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall study the utilization
- of all facilities on the state capitol grounds, including an evaluation of facility needs by state
- 6 agencies and a review of the capitol complex master plan. The study must include an
- 7 evaluation of the short-term and long-term viability of facilities located on the capitol grounds,
- 8 including the governor's residence. The legislative council shall report its findings and
- 9 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 10 the sixty-second legislative assembly.
