- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-16-04.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to powers and duties of the emergency commission and budget section; to amend and
- 3 reenact section 54-16-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to emergency
- 4 commission requests; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-16-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **54-16-03.1. Submission of petition to emergency commission.** When an
- 9 emergency exists, a state officer may present to the emergency commission an itemized
- 10 petition requesting approval to transfer money and spending authority between funds or line
- 11 items pursuant to section 54-16-04; accept and expend federal funds pursuant to section
- 12 54-16-04.1; accept and expend state contingency funds pursuant to section 54-16-09; er accept
- 13 and expend other funds pursuant to section 54-16-04.2; or recommend full-time equivalent
- 14 positions pursuant to section 54-16-04.3.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** Section 54-16-04.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
- 16 enacted as follows:
- 17 Commission may recommend full-time equivalent positions Budget section
- 18 **approval.** On the advice of the office of management and budget and upon the
- 19 recommendation of the emergency commission, the budget section of the legislative council
- 20 may authorize a state officer to employ full-time equivalent positions in addition to those
- 21 <u>authorized by the legislative assembly. The authority to employ a full-time equivalent position</u>
- 22 <u>under this section is effective only for the remainder of the biennium during which the authority</u>
- 23 is granted by the budget section.
- 24 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective July 1, 2009.

1 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
