## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.2-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **39-06.2-08.** Application for commercial driver's license.
- 9 1. The application for a commercial driver's license or commercial driver's instruction permit must include the following:
  - a. The full name and current mailing address of the person applicant;
  - A physical description of the person applicant, including sex, height, weight, and eye and hair color;
- 14 c. Date of birth;
- d. The applicant's social security number, unless the application is for a
  temporary nonresident commercial driver's license and the applicant is a
  resident of a foreign jurisdiction;
- e. The <del>person's</del> <u>applicant's</u> signature;
- f. The certifications including those required by 49 CFR part 383.71(a);
- 20 g. Any other information required by the director; and
- 21 h. A consent to release driving record information.
- 22 <u>2.</u> The application must be accompanied by an application fee of fifteen dollars.

- When the holder of a commercial driver's license changes the holder's name or mailing address, an application for a duplicate license must be made as provided in section 39-06-18.
  - 3. 4. No person An individual who has been a resident of this state for thirty days may not drive a commercial motor vehicle under the authority of a commercial driver's license issued by another jurisdiction.
  - 4. <u>5.</u> Any person individual who knowingly falsifies information or certifications required under subsection 1 is subject to suspension, revocation, or cancellation of the person's individual's commercial driver's license for a period of at least sixty consecutive days.
  - **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 39-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Temporary nonresident license.

- 1. The department may issue a temporary nonresident commercial driver's license to an applicant who does not present a social security card as required by section 39-06.2-08 but who otherwise meets the requirements for a nonresident commercial driver's license. A license issued under this subsection may not be renewed and expires on the earlier of the sixtieth day after the date the license is issued, the expiration date of a temporary worker visa presented to the department, or the expiration date of the form I-94 arrival/departure record or a successor document presented to the department. If an individual with a valid temporary nonresident commercial license provides a social security number to the department, the department shall issue a nonresident commercial license. The department shall renew without a skills or knowledge test a nonresident commercial license that has been expired for a duration not longer than one year.
- The department may not issue more than one temporary nonresident commercial driver's license per applicant.
- 3. The fee for a temporary nonresident commercial driver's license is twenty dollars.
